

# Care for children with psychical diseases and/or behavioral diseases in « regular » school in France



#### School system in France

- Mandatory school attendance from 6 to 16 years
- System at « regular » school
  - \* Kindergarten: 3-6 years
  - \* 1.st part of elementary school: 6-11 years
  - \* 2.nd part of elementary school: 11-15 years
  - High schools and training schools: 15-18 years
  - College/ University



# School system in France taking problematic students into account

- School support
- \* PPRE: Individual education success program: Assessment of pedagogical team, for preventive actions and problem reduction
- \* Admittance conditions for newly coming students in France.
- \* RASED: Network of specialized help for students in need (kindergarten and 1.st part of elementary school), aimed at students in difficult situation and



# School system in France taking problematic students into account

- EGPA: Section of general and specialized social education (2.nd part of elementary school): special classes for students with severe and long term learning problems
- EREA: Regional social education facility (2.nd part of elementary school high school): schooling for children with school and/or family social difficulties as boarding school + preparation for specific vocational certificates



# School system in France Conditions of school inclusion in France

- \* « Disabled » children may attend regular classes
- \* Possible support:
  - \* AVS: School support staff
  - \* Specific equipment (Example: computer with programs for specific disabilities)
  - \* Organization of examination (1/3 extra time, accompaniment, use of computers...)



# School system in France Programs of school inclusion in France

- \* When schooling in regular class is too difficult, there are specific programs for children with disability.
- \* Programs are integrated into specific « regular » school facilities.
- \* Admittance to those programs is possible only with agreement of MDPH commission and family application for admittance.



### School system in France

#### Local school inclusion class (CLIS)

- Special teacher
- Maximum of 12 children
- \* 6-12 years of age
- Assigned to 1<sup>st</sup> part of elementary school
- Amount of inclusion into « regular » classes depends on child abilities and its school program.



### School system in France

#### Local school inclusion units (ULIS)

- Special teacher
- Maximum of 10 children
- \* 12-16 years (ULIS 2<sup>nd</sup> part of elementary school), 16-19 years (ULIS high school)
- \* Assigned to 2<sup>nd</sup> part of elementary school or to high school
- \* Amount of inclusion into « regular » classes depends on child abilities and its school program.



# School system in France PPS: individual school programs

- \* For all children assessed by MDPH commission as disabled
- \* Made by team over watching school curricula.
- Minimal 1 year meeting time
- Leadership: Referent teacher
- Include: teachers, physicians and school psychologists, health and social partners, **family**, **and if possible**, **child itself**.



## School system in France PPS: individual school programs

- Assessment of educational abilities
- Discussion, opinions of each attendee
- Summary of necessary educational needs
- Recommendation for integration into next school project
- \* Conclusions given to MDPH commission
- \* Examination and incorporation of individual program by MDPH commission



- CAMSP: Center for early childhood social and health services
  - Children form age of 0 to 6
  - \* Attend to sensory, motoric or mental problems.
  - \* Analyze, diagnostics, treatment, rehabilitation and observation of children with disability before and/or during school attendance.
  - \* Possibility of group meeting in referral facility instead of school attendance.



- \* CMPI: Psychological health children center
  - Psychiatric hospital department
  - Children and youth of age from 0 to 16 years
  - \* Individual care
  - Group therapy
  - Day service, it is possible to alternate with school in referral facility
  - \* Therapeutic facility (for times out of school attendance)



#### **SESSAD Arc En Ciel:** Acreditation

- \* Mental retardation
- \* 0-20 years of age
- \* Funded by social services administrations (government)
- \* Report to MDPH commission
- \* Principle is to be active on places of children regular life (schools, nursery, free time centers, home...)



#### SESSAD Arc En Ciel: Staff

- ✓ Education team: Teachers of children and youth
- ✓ Special teachers
- ✓ Physicians and medical team: Children physician, psychiatrist, rehabilitation workers, speech therapists, psychomotorics experts
- ✓ Psychologists
- ✓ Office
- √ Headquarters (1 director of facility)



#### SESSAD Arc En Ciel: Tasks/ mission

- **→** General care:
- \* Counseling and assistance to families and child surroundings
- \* Diagnostics enrichment
- \* Help with development of child psychomotorics basics
- Preparation of next assignment
- Support of school integration and gaining of self

#### Role of SESSAD in school system

- \* Individual actions
- Group actions
- \* Connection with teacher
- Connection with school support staff
- \* Attendance to meetings of team over watching school facility
- Help for parents during schooling / disability and orientation



#### **SESSAD Arc En Ciel:**

#### Main methods of help:

#### PIA: Individual help plan

- > Prepared by referral teacher, based on observation
- Processed by multi disciplinary team
- Elaboration of work goals for child and with child, youth or young adult
- ➤ Means, that facility can use

- \* SESSAD can help children, which are oriented into regular school or mentioned facilities environment by MDPH commission. It works as a **partner** with all potential partakers in every situation.
- \* If disability prevents child from placement into regular school class or into facility for school inclusion, parents may require placement in special facility (IME).



\* IME:



- Children and youth with mental retardation and/or combined disabilities
- School attendance (length and content individually adapted for each child)
- Technical education
- General education accompaniment


### IME: Medical education facility

\* Medical care (logopedy, psychomotoric, ergo-therapy, physical-therapy...)

Possibility of boarding school

\* Orientation of MDPH commissio

In the case of admission to this facility, SESSAD's work is over.





# ITEP: Therapeutic, education and pedagogical institute

- \* Children and youth with psychological problems, meaning expression problems and especially with behavioral problems, which severely disrupt socialization and access to education.
- Protected mental potential
- \* Multidisciplinary approach with vision of care
- Possibility of boarding school
- Possibility of accommodation
