

Utilization of Therapies when Educating Pupils in One-year Practical School and Two-year Practical School

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Practical School

- * One-year Practical School 78-62-C/01 (total 10 pupils)
- * Two-year Practical School 78-62-C/02 (total 39 pupils)

In Practical School pupils with SEN are educated:

- Pupils with light mental retardation (total 11 pupils)
- Pupils with moderate mental retardation (total 20 pupils)
- Pupils with autism (total 3 pupils)
- Pupils with multiple disabilities (total 13 pupils including MR and physical disabilities - 10 pupils, MR and hearing impairment - 1 pupil, MR and visual impairment - 2 pupils)
- Blind pupils (total 2 pupils)

Therapies in Educational Process

In 2008 we managed to get funding from the ESF from OP "Education for Competitiveness" for the project "Modern environment for modern teaching". We wrote the project ourselves and in its implementation we applied the experience gained in many years of educational work with pupils with handicap. Among other things the project focused on integration of therapies into educational process of pupils with special educational needs.

Into educational process we incorporated:

- Music therapy
- Occupational therapy
- Drama therapy
- * Art therapy

Therapies in Educational Process - Music Therapy

Music Therapy is a targeted use of sounds and music for therapeutic purposes. Therefore Music therapy is about using music to achieve positive changes in psychological, physical, cognitive and social functioning of an individual with health or educational problems.

Targets of Music Therapy:

- * Enables the fulfillment of various physical, emotional, intelectual, social and other needs of an individual
- * The cure, learning, development of social interaction and communication, self-expression, motivation, pain and stress management,
- * Develops the relationship between the client and the therapist through common musical experience and communication
- * Improves quality of life, personal and spiritual development of an individual

Therapies in Educational Process - Occupational Therapy

Occupational Therapy is a therapy of motor-intelectual functions and social skills in order to achieve independence in personal, social and work life. It develops various work skills of the person with disability in the way that it is possible to incorporate him/her successfully into fulfilling life.

Targets of Occupational Therapy Intervention:

- * Through work to achieve improvement of functional demage in individuals
- * To prevent progression and formation of secondary demage
- To achieve maximum autonomy (self-sufficiency)

Occupational therapy develops or improves gross and fine motor skills, motor coordination, visual-motor coordination, improves communication of pupils with special educational needs.

Therapies in Educational Process - Drama Therapy

Drama Therapy is an intentional use of drama and theatre practices that evoke experience of emotions, gaining internal harmony. It works with the imagination of the individual.

Targets of Drama Therapy:

- * Teaches growing openess of self-confidence, reducing negative attitudes, relieves symptoms of impairment, alternatively teaches to live with them
- * Develops skills of orientation in social situations, teaches how to react adequately in various social roles
- Removes stress factors and personal tension, has an impact on total relief, relaxation, overcoming barriers in ourselves and in the relation to others
- * Develops empathy, creativity, self-confidence, self-awareness, develops cognitive processes and emotionality
- * Improves the quality of life of individuals

Therapies in Educational Processes - Art Therapy

Art Therapy is based on the artistic expression of individuals as the main therapeutic agent. It is about the art creation, where the result is not important, but the process of creation, the joy of activity.

Art Therapy techniques are suitable mainly:

- To support the personal development of children develops selfawareness, knowing others and communication
- For shy and anxious children
- For aggressive children
- * As the prevention of occurrence undesirable behaviour
- * To develop tolerence to children that are somehow different from others (racial difference, children with handicap etc.)
- To release the tension

Preconditions for Implementation of Therapies into Educational Process in Practical School

- * Building special therapeutical classrooms
- * Therapeutical classrooms equipped with special tools
- * Education of educational workers
- Creation of methodological material for educational workers

Utilization of Therapies among Pupils of One-year Practical School and Two-year Practical School

Therapies are used:

- * In leisure education in therapeutic workshops
- * At excursions
- * At adaptive stay of practical school
- * At implementation of therapies into teaching

Leisure Education in Therapeutic Workshops

- Therapeutic Workshop of Art Therapy
- Therapeutic Workshop of Occupational Therapy
- Therapeutic Workshop of Music Therapy
- Therapeutic Workshop of Drama Therapy

Therapeutic workshops are held once in 14 days (or once a week), always in the afternoon (after school). Pupils attend the workshops voluntarily according to their own interest. The workshops are lead by teaching staff who have been trained in the field of therapies.

Methods and Means of Music Therapy

- * Playing the musical instrument
- * singing
- Tapping the rhythm
- * Music-motor plays, playing on the body
- Listening and experience of music
- * Orff instruments
- * Preparatory breathing exercisesůpravná
- * Relaxation and breathing techniques

- * Practice of everyday activities (dressing, cooking, housework, shopping, etc.)
- * Handling various subjects
- * Creative activities

Methods and Means of Drama Therapy

- * Empatic behaviour, correction of behaviour, opinions and attitudes
- * Establishing of contact, communication, stimulation
- Games to develop perception, relaxation, concentration, sensory games
- * Dramatic methods and techniques plays with a glove puppet, work with a story, mime, dance drama, theatre, dialogue improvization







Integration of Therapies in Teaching

Trained educational workers implement therapeutic methods into teaching within their subjects:

- * Educational art therapy
- * Educational drama therapy
- * Educational occupational therapy
- Educational music therapy

Educational Music Therapy

Connecting to teaching

Music therapy finds its application primarily in lessons of music, Czech language, family and health education, PT, art, drama, music and motor education and health education.

Educational Occupational Therapy

Connecting to teaching:

Occupational therapy methods are mainly used in subjects focused on pupils gaining job skills. That is teaching in professional subjects, preparing meals, handicrafts, technical education, gardening.

Educational Drama Therapy

Connecting to teaching:

Drama therapy finds its application in almost all the subjects at school. Within teaching in educational process of pupils with special educational needs it is mainly incorporated into Czech language, civic education, family and health education, drama education, social education, music and physical education.

Educational Art Therapy

Connecting to teaching:

Art therapy methods are primarily used in art and handicraft subjects.

That is teaching of art education, preparing meals, handicrafts, family and health education, gardening.

Benefits of Therapies for Pupils in One-year Practical School and Two-year Practical School

- * Enrichment of the teaching of pupils with nontraditional elements, methods and forms of work
- * Elimination of health problems at individual pupils
- * Easier and nonviolent inclusion of shy pupils into class
- * Development of fine and gross motor skills
- * Suitable and meaningful use of leisure time after school
- * Appearance and product presentations in the public e.g. Children Days at Silesian-Ostrava castle, Senior Days, European Days of Handicap etc.

Benefits of Therapies for Educational Workers

- * Better knowledge of pupils, understanding their problems and handicaps
- * Teaching with interesting methods
- * Work satisfaction
- Opportunity for further self-education
- Development of self-awareness, empathy, fantasy and creativity
- Team building of the teaching staff

- * Improvement of the social climate at school
- * Increasing the skills of teaching staff training
- * Application of innovative methods and procedures and improvement of the quality of teaching
- * School publicity in the media on introducing therapies into teaching there was a television report made and several newspaper articles were published
- * Achievement of higher prestige of the school (interest in education at our school)
